Can animals talk to each other?

Animals use sounds to communicate with each other. What may sound like hoots and honks to us can make perfect sense to another animal of the same species. They can convey happiness, fear, love, anger and other emotions.

A lion's roar is the loudest of any big cat. It can be heard from a distance of about eight km!



Chimpanzees can tell each other how they feel through expressions and touch. Scientists have found out that *huuu* means "what" and an *aaaa* while eating means good food!

Things to do

Listen carefully to a dog or cat. Do these animals have different woofs and meows for different feelings like joy, fear and excitement?

Do animals communicate only through sounds?

Animals use two kinds of sound to communicate. Vertebrates use vocal language or sounds like we do. These sounds are made in the throat, mouth or some part of the respiratory system. Some animals produce sounds using different parts of the body. Crickets rub their raspy wings together to produce sounds, while rattlesnakes have a modified tail tip that produces a rattling sound to warn off enemies. Animals also lick and rub against each other to show their affection.

Whales and dolphins slap the surface of water with their tails and jump out of water to warn each other of danger or to attract females.



Insects like the male cicada have membranes under their wings called tymbals which vibrate to produce sound.

Bats can make different sounds to convey different messages. In fact, after humans, bats use the most number of vocal messages but, since the sounds are of ultra high frequency, the human ear cannot hear them!

Birds produce sounds through the bony syrinx in the trachea or wind pipe. Birds sing to mark their territory or to impress female birds.

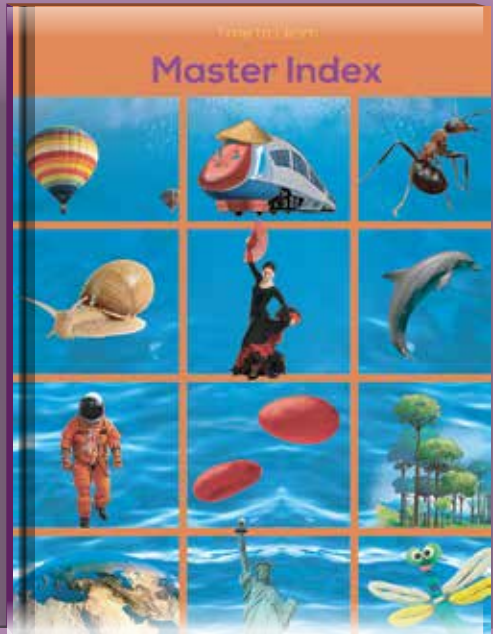

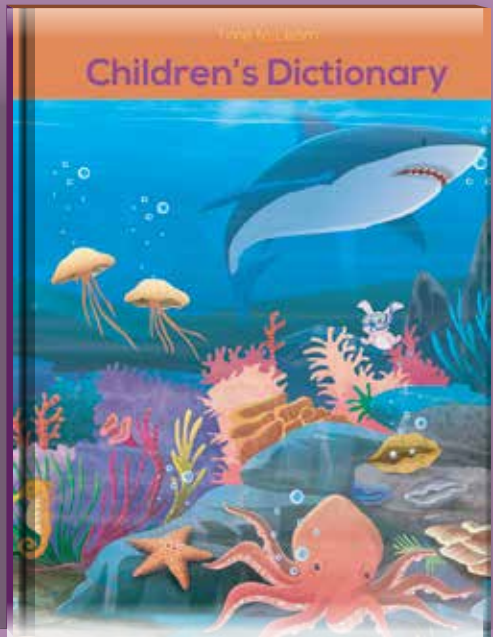

Listening to the sounds with Eltee Pen

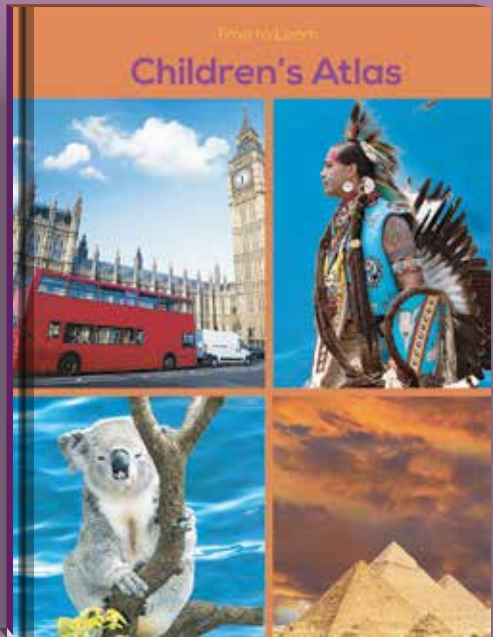
- Eltee Pen is an audio-learning device that is supplied with Time to Learn.

- Also provides a list of songs in each book that can be heard through the Eltee Pen.



- **Children's Dictionary** teaches your child 1500 new words with meaning, usage and correct pronunciation.

- Beautiful illustrations help children to better understand and remember the words.

Activation and types of sounds

 - Any printed text in the selected language.

Record and playback

Your child can record her voice using the Eltee Pen. This feature is particularly helpful to compare your child's pronunciation of the key words with that of the perfect pronunciation. The User Manual explains this feature further.

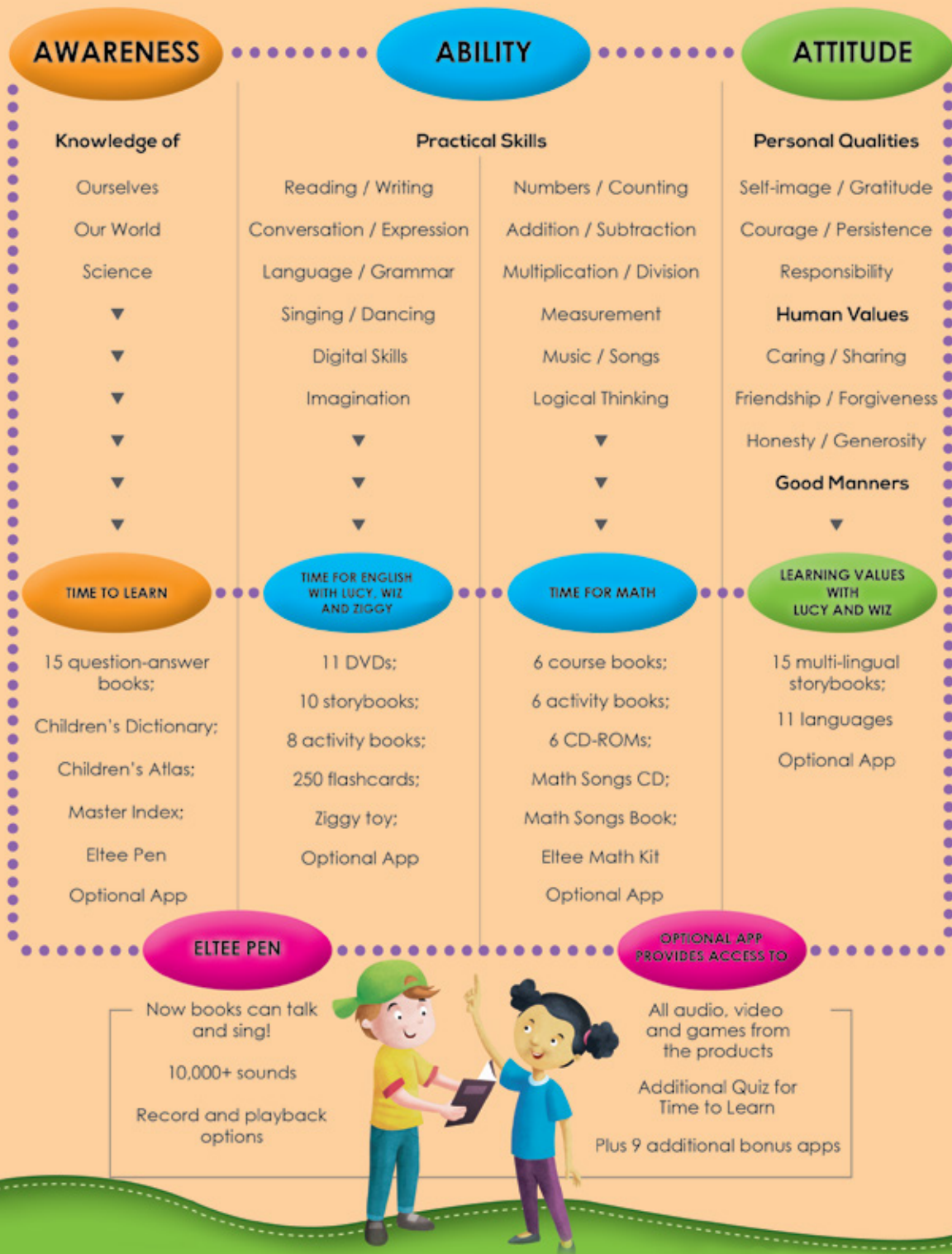
